A BRIEF HISTORY

- 1947: TA = Trappers Association was formed in Sudbury
- 1959: OTA = Ontario Trappers Council established
 - John Burnham, Llyod Cook founding fathers
 - Alec Shieff, manager of OTA (1971)
- 1995: Merger of the three Ontario fur organizations (TA, OTA & OFMC) took place and was renamed the Ontario Fur Managers Federation (OFMF) which was recognized by Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources





Ontario Fur Managers Federation

- AKA: OFMF
 - ONTARIO FUR MANAGEA

- 1995: established
- Office Located in Sault Ste. Marie
- General Managers: Ron Lessard was loaned by MNR in Sault Ste Marie to be an interim GM. Howard Noseworthy took the position, then Barry Cordingley, Brett Rob, Robin Horwath, Lauren Tonelli and Tyler Epp.
- Mandate: Managing Ontario's Furbearers for today and tomorrow.
- **50** Their Mission:
 - To promote the conservation and sustainability of fur bearers & the ecosystem.
 - To promote the general welfare of the trappers of Ontario.
 - To promote the humane harvest of fur bearers on a continual basis.
 - To promote and participate in the continuing education of fur harvesters.
 - To promote and participate in public education and awareness.
 - To represent the trappers of Ontario in any and all resource management issues.






